FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

(FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

Pull 5 1/2" casing and plug well as follows: Cut off 5 1/2" casing at approx. 2210' and pull. Fill hole with 10# mud, set 10 sx cement plug at 3149', top of casing perforations, set 20 sx cement plug at 2210' in stub of 5 1/2" casing, set 15 sx cement plug in open hole at top of salt at 1440', set 10 sx cement plug at base of 8 5/8" surface casing at 325', set 5 sx cement plug in 8 5/8" surface casing at surface. Place 4" iron pipe marker in cement plug at surface of well to extend 4' above ground level and mark pipe as follows, Joseph I. O'Neill, Jr., Medlin "A" #6, SE 1/4 SE 1/4 S-8, T-15S, R-31E, Chaves Co., New Mexico. Remove dead men anchors and clean location. This well was drilled in July 1955 and did not produce any oil or gas ; therefore, it was temporarily abandoned.

Verbal approval to do the above listed work was obtained from Mr. E. J. Fischer per telephone conversation to C. L. Fly, Jr. May 10, 1957.
