

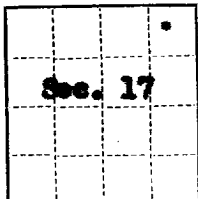

DETAILS OF WORK

Drill well with rotary tools to test Queen Sand at approximately 2930'.
Set 8-5/8" 32# casing at approximately 150' in 11" hole cemented to surface.
Set 5-1/2" 17# casing at approximately 2930' in 7-7/8" hole, Queen Sand formation, with cement circulated to surface.
Will use saturated salt water until casing point is reached, then mud up to run oil string.
To drill pay zone with oil and fracture treat for completion.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

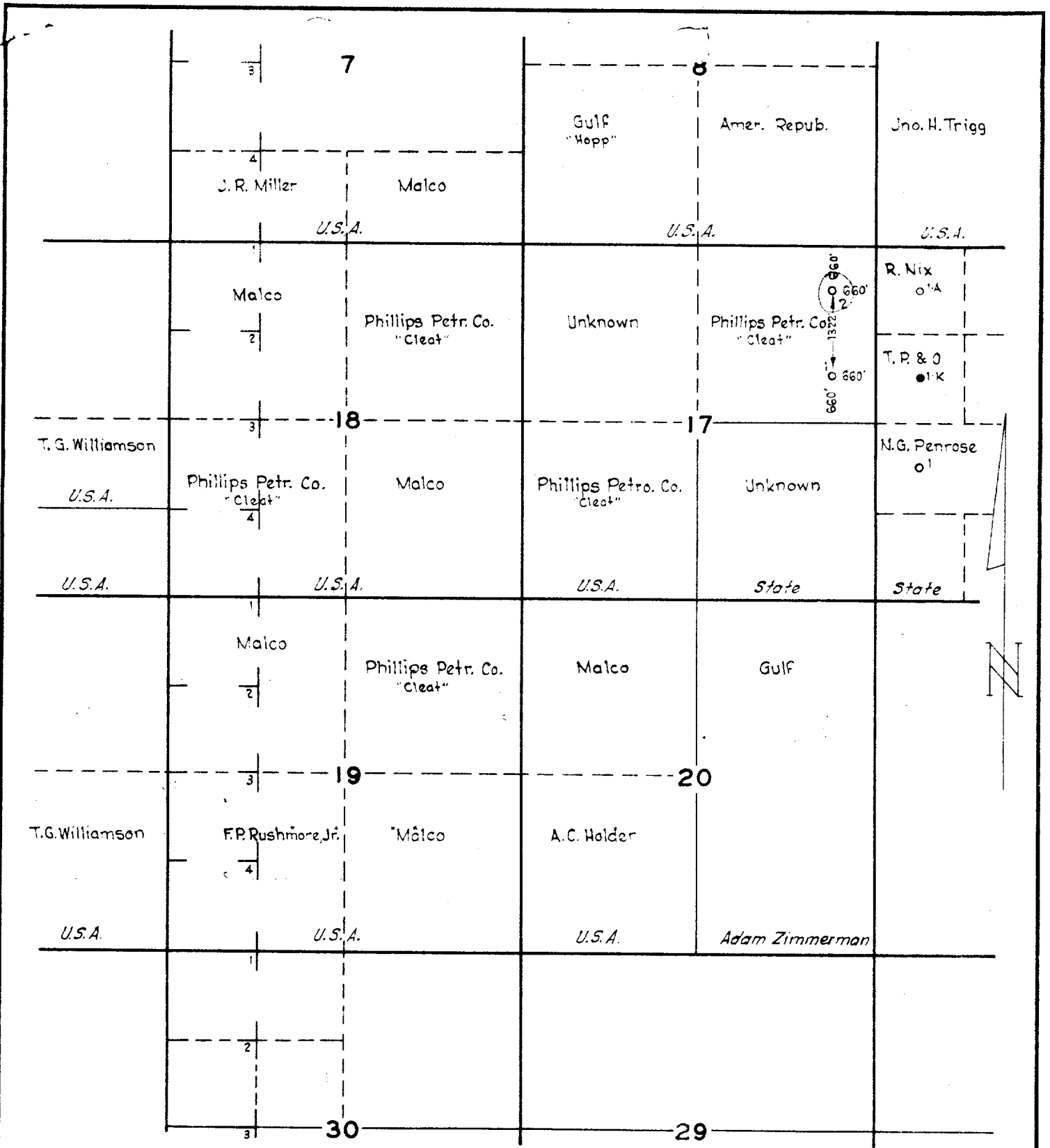
