Tamped with pea gravel from 3023 to 3030.

Dumped 7 sacks Cal-Seal from 2990 to 3023.

Filled hole with oil. Shot at 7:25 A.M. 8-31-49.

Drilled Cal-Seal and cleaned out to total depth of 3054.

Swab test showed 45 barrels first 24 hours.

Run tubing and put on pump 9-8-49. Production first 24 hours was 45 barrels per day.
