FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

Production has continued to decline on this well since its completion. It is believed possible that there is possible restriction due to scale formation or other foreign material in the well here. It is our intention to chemically treat the well with acid through 5-1/2" casing perforations from 11,010' to 11,026' with 500 gallons 15% L.T. acid, then allow the well to produce for four to five days and treat with 4,000 gallons of 15% L.T. acid. The well was completed 8-6-50, total depth of 11,040', Drilled Out Depth 11,030', 5-1/2" casing perforated from 11,010' to 11,026' w/64 shots, washed w/250 gallons of 15% L.T. Acid.
