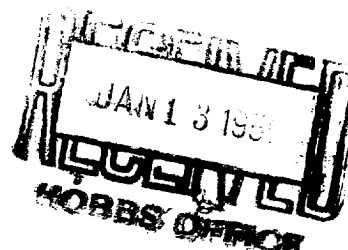

10,620' Total Depth - Lins. 9475' D.O.D. Ran Temperature Survey - Top cement on outside 5-1/2" casing 5500', actual fill 3925', ratio of actual to calculated fill 104.8%. Connected 5-1/2" casing, ran 4-3/4" bit & 2-3/8" OD. EUE tubing and tested 5-1/2" casing & well head connections with 500# for 1/2 hr. - no pressure drop. Drilled cement to 9432' Circulated hole clean and tested 5-1/2" casing with 500# for 1/2 hr. - no pressure drop. Proceeded with completion operations.

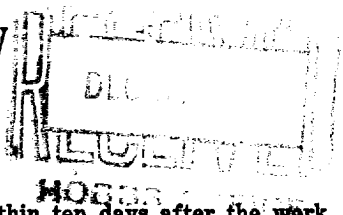
