## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Ran 7 joints 282' of 12-3/4" OD 50# R-3 casing. Set and cemented at 303' w/400 sacks regular El Toro cement. Plug at 280'. Maximum pressure 200#. cement circulated.

After waiting over 24 hours tested 12-3/4" casing w/800# pressure for 30 minutes. There was no drop in pressure. Drilled cement plug from 280' to 303', tested cement below casing shoe w/400# pressure for 30 minutes. There was no drop in pressure.

After approval of Mr. Yarbrough, State Oil and Gas Inspector, preparations were made to drill ahead.
