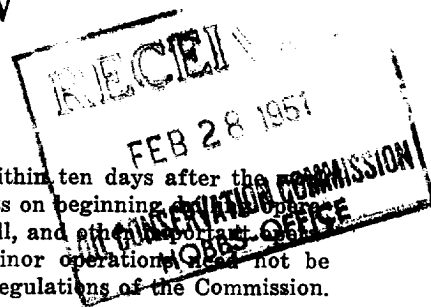

A temperature survey was run which indicated that the top of the cement behind the 9-5/8" casing was at 470 feet. After waiting 48 hours the casing was tested with 1,000 pounds for 30 minutes. There was no drop in pressure.
