Gentlemen:

TEXACO Inc. respectfully requests that a hearing be set to consider its application for a combination conventional-tubingless completion for the H.H. Harris Well No. 2. This well will be completed in the Bronco (Wolfcamp) Pool and Bronco (Siluro-Devonian) Pool, Lea County, New Mexico. In support of our application we wish to state the following facts:

1. TEXACO Inc. is the Operator of the H.H. Harris Lease containing 302.67 acres and consisting of the S/2 of Section 35, Township 12 South, Range 38 East, Lea County, New Mexico.

2. H.H. Harris Well No. 2 is located in Unit 0 of said Section 35.

3. The Siluro-Devonian zone will be an oil completion through casing perforations from approximately 11,792 feet to 11,833 feet.

4. The Wolfcamp zone will be an oil completion through casing perforations from approximately 9,000 feet to 9,040 feet.

5. The Wolfcamp zone is expected to require pumping and it will be produced through 2-7/8 inch casing cemented in a common well bore with 3-1/2 inch casing that will serve the Siluro-Devonian zone. The Siluro-Devonian zone is expected to flow and it will be produced through 1-1/2 inch tubing.

Attached is an Application for Multiple Completion and a plat of the H.H. Harris Lease. It is respectfully requested that this application be set for hearing on the first available hearing docket.
