## DETAILS OF WORK

(State names of and expected depths to objective sands; show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudding jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work)

We propose to drill this well through the Red Sand zone found at approximately 3300 feet and then continue drilling through the regular Maljamar Pay (Grayburg-San Andres Formation) to a depth of approximately 4200 feet. We propose to diamond core the Red Sand zone and also the Maljamar Pay and will set 5 1/2" casing through the Maljamar Pay to the total depth of approximately 4200 feet and will cement this string of casing with approximately 600 sacks of cement or enough cement to reach the top of the salt. We also plan to run approximately 60' of 4-5/8" casing and will cement with enough cement to bring cement to surface. Upon completion we propose to leave the regular Maljamar Pay cased off and set a bridging plug at the base of the Red Sand, perforate the Red Sand zone and sand-oil treat before placing the well on production.

This is an unorthodox location approved by the M.I.G.C.C. May 19, 1954.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
