Rigged up swab unit, cut paraffin. On 24 hr flow test recovered 80 bbls. plo on 1/4" choke. Tubing pressure 70#, Corr Gravity 37.6, 162.97 mcf/day, GOR 2009. Flowing oil well thru perforations in 5 1/2" csg 10,713 - 10,723.
