Notice is hereby given pursuant to Rule 701 B 3 of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division Rules and Regulations that it is the intent of Charles B. Gillespie, Jr., to utilize the Charles B. Gillespie, Jr., State D Well No. 3 located 3000 feet from the South line and 330 feet from the West line of Section 1, Township 16 South, Range 35 East, Lea County, New Mexico, for the underground disposal of production formation water from the Charles B. Gillespie, Jr. wells located in Sections 1, Township 16 South, Range 35 East, and Sections 5 and 6, Township 16 South, Range 36 East. Disposal will average 200 barrels per day but could go as high as 350 barrels per day. Maximum injection pressure will not exceed 2100 pounds per square inch.
