Gentlemen:

The location of subject well was inspected and the present condition of the well bore does not conform to our requirements. We require that the well be either permanently plugged and abandoned or, if temporarily plugged and abandoned, that surface pipe be run and cemented to surface and swage and valve (closed) be installed at the surface.

It is also necessary that you file the following forms immediately:

- (1) C-103, "Results of Casing Shut-off", if any casing was run
- (2) C-105, "Well Record"
- (3) C-102, "Miscellaneous Notices"—check opposite "Notice of Intention to Plug Well" and outline your proposed plan of plugging for our approval.

I might add here that due to the fact that, to our knowledge no pipe was ever run and there is at present no pipe in the hole as far as we can ascertain, it will be necessary that you cement from bottom (350') to top and install a properly inscribed marker.

When work is completed, file Form C-103 outlining work that was performed. This C-103 will be approved after the well and location have been inspected.

Please fill out all forms as completely as possible and to the best of your knowledge.
