FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK
(FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

Original plans were to complete Shelton No. 2 in the Devonian Dolomite; however the present total depth is 13,500' with no oil show. We propose to test the Pennsylvanian pay zone as following:

- (1) Run 5½" casing and cement at 11,620 feet with 650 sacks of cement - leaving 90 feet cement plug in casing and mud laden fluid below to plug off Devonian.
- (2) Perforate 5½" casing opposite the Pennsylvanian Pay Zone with 4 Du Pont 26A jet shots per foot and test.
