If changes in the above plan become advisable we will notify you before cementing or landing casing. We estimate that the first productive oil or gas sand should occur at a depth of about 9500 feet.

Additional information: Permission has been granted by P.A.D. to use 9-5/8" casing for intermediate string. If, however, 8-5/8" can be obtained it will be used instead of 9-5/8" in order to conserve steel. If 8-5/8" is used, the size of hole cut below surface casing will be smaller than as
