DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Ran 134 Jts. 4688' of 9-5/8" OD 40# & 36# H-40 J-55 SS casing w/Baker shoe & floats & three Weatherford Centralizers and 13 scratchers from 4695' to 4547'. Set & cemented at 4699' w/2650 sax cement, 2500 sax 4 1/2 Gel & 150 sax Neat on bottom. Plug at 4654'. Max pressure 1300#.

After waiting over 36 hrs., tested 9-5/8" casing w/1000# for 30 min, no drop in pressure. Drilled cement plug from 4600' to 4699', tested cement below casing shoe w/800# for 30 min no drop in pressure.

After approval of Mr. Yarbrough, State Oil & Gas Inspector, preparations were made to drill ahead.
