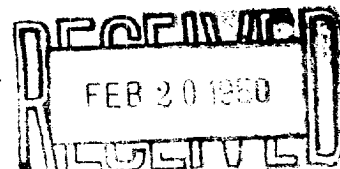

FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

This well was drilled to the depth of 11,414 on February 3, 1950 at which time drilling mud returns were completely lost. Drilling operations were continued with no mud returns until February 14, 1950 at which time the total depth of 12,015 was reached. While attempting to condition the hole so that Schlumberger could be run the drill pipe failed as the result of a wash out and fishing operations recovered all but 471' of drill pipe, drill collars and bit. Schlumberger was subsequently run to 11,418' and it is now planned to plug and abandon the hole. It is planned to set a wire line bridge plug at approximately 4800' and place a 200' cement plug on top of the bridge plug, after which a plate will be welded over the top of the 9-5/8" casing and a well marker provided as required by Commission regulations. A summary report of this plugging operation will be filed at a later date.
