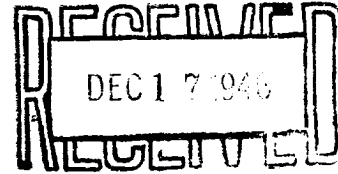

We expect to set 8-5/8" O.D. casing at approximately 2,100' and cement with 500 sacks cement. 1,200# pressure will be applied before and after drilling plug and allowed to stand for 30 minutes to check for pressure decline. We expect to do this work on December 18th, 1946.
