DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

This well was acidized with 10,000 gallons of acid(1000 gallons of Dowell jel-acid and 9,000 gallons of Dowell F-29 with M-18) through casing perforations @ 11,080-11,100' and 11,130-11,150'. Before acidizing the well Flowed an average of 280 BOPD on 1/2" choke with a tubing pressure of 75 psig; since acidizing the well has averaged 310 BOPD on a 1/2" choke with a tubing pressure of 150 Psig.
