DST No. 4 - (2-2-54) 3 hours 12,867-12,900, 3000 water cushion, good blow throughout test, recovered 2' gas cut free oil, 1893' slightly oil & gas cut water blanket, 710' slightly oil cut & moderately was out water blanket, 397' very slightly oil cut & mud cut & heavily gas cut water blanket, 3030' very slightly oil & moderately gas cut salt water.
