This well was temporarily abandoned by mudding the hole to the surface. This well is in a pressure maintenance area and may possibly be used for other purposes at some future date; therefore, no casing was disturbed, although the well was capped and the customary 4" OD pipe marker installed.

This well was recently worked over with negative results in an attempt to increase production. The well was tested after remedial work for no oil, 13 BWPD, and no gas, hence the desire to temporarily abandon.
