Detailed account of work done, nature and quantity of materials used and results obtained.

The above well was spudded at 8:25 A. M., June 16, 1958. We ran 10 joints of J-55, 48# 13 3/8" casing, total of 294.46', landed @ 291', cemented with 300 sac 50 - 50 posmix, 2% gel added, and 2% Calcium Chloride. Cement circulated, plug down @ 11:45 P. M. on 6-16-58. Halliburton did the cementing. After allowing the cement to set 24 hours, drilling was resumed. Depth @ 6:00 A. M., June 20, 1958 was 2212'.
