
Reference is made to your application dated July 9, 1993 for a non-standard oil well location for the purpose of completing an efficient production/injection pattern within the Johns Waterflood Project Area, established by Division Order Nos. R-3011 and R-3011-A.

It is our understanding that the proposed Johns "B-DE" Well No. 15 is to be drilled 1305 feet from the North line and 1336 feet from the East line (Unit B) of Section 24, Township 17 South, Range 32 East, NMPM, Maljamar Grayburg-San Andres Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

The NW/4 NE/4 of said Section 24 shall be dedicated to said well forming a standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of General Rule 104 F(I) and Division Order No. R-3011-A, the above-described unorthodox oil well location is hereby approved.
