The Lusk Deep Unit #2 was completed March 31, 1961 as a dual between the Strawn (Lusk-Strawn Pool) and the Morrow (Undesignated). It is our intention at this time to produce only the Strawn oil zone, with the Morrow gas zone shut-in. It is also our intention to leave the Morrow gas zone shut-in until such time as a gas pipe line connection is available for this area. We request your permission to delay running of a packer leakage test between these two zones until such time as a pipe line connection is available, in order to prevent the waste of natural gas in flowing it to the atmosphere. At such time as the pipe line connection is available, we will notify your office and conduct a packer leakage test as required by the State of New Mexico under Rule 304. At that time, we will also conduct our multiple point potential test of the Morrow Zone, producing it into the pipe line, in order to prevent the waste of natural resources.

If the above procedures meet with your approval, please sign and return the attached copy of this letter in the enclosed stamped addressed envelope.

The Lusk Deep Unit #2 was completed in 1961 as a dual

oil zone, with the Morrow gas zone shut-in. It is also our in-
tention to leave the Morrow gas zone shut-in until such time as
a gas pipe line connection is available to the well. The request
your permission to delay running of a packer leakage test between
these two zones until such time as a pipe line connection is available,
in order to prevent the waste of natural gas to flowing it to the
atmosphere. At such time as the pipe line connection is available,
we will notify your office and conduct a packer leakage test as required
by the State of New Mexico under Rule 304. At that time, we will also
conduct our multiple point potential test of the Morrow Zone, pro-
ducing it into the pipe line, in order to prevent the waste of natural
resources.
