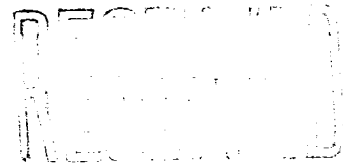

On March 12, 1944 we run 4028' of 7" O.D. Casing on the above well, cementing same with 100 sacks of cement, 50 sacks of mud used ahead circulated. International Cementers doing the work. We will allow the cement to set 72 hours and test for the water shut-off. After the test has been made we will forward the results of same.
