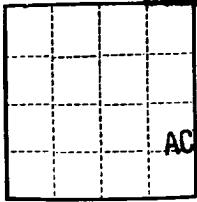

DETAILS OF WORK

We propose to recomplete this Queen Sand well in the Lower Yates formation. A 5/8" plug will be set at approximately 3700 ft. to plug off the presently producing Queen sand formation. We propose to log this well and perforate the Lower Yates section as indicated by said log.


We propose to sand-oil fracture the Lower Yates section with 20,000 gal. of lease crude and approximately 30,000 lb. of frac sand.

The calculated cement top outside the 5 1/2" casing is 2970' according to annular volume.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
