C-102 was submitted April 1, 1952 requesting approval to P&A Hardin Well No. 4 and approval was received. The work was not completed. A request was submitted to SI the well until it was determined whether recompletion as a gas well is feasible. It is entirely possible that this well may be used for secondary recovery or salt water disposal if not permanently plugged. It is requested that permission be granted to continue the status of this well as shut in. It is believed that this procedure is amply justified both from an economic and a conservation stand point.
