Set High Pressure Separator at State No. 4, Sec. 29, T-18-S, R-38-E, to conserve High Pressure gas produced with the oil from this well and transport same to the Company's McKinley Lease, Sec. 20, T-18-S, R-38-E, for the purpose of gas lift on McKinley Nos. 1 and 2 wells. These wells now have flow valves installed so that a minimum amount of gas will be required for gas-lifting. An orifice meter will be installed to measure the gas used for this purpose and measurements reported to you monthly. Please advise at what price we pay royalty to the State for gas so used.

PHILOSOPHY

4. Finally, the author concludes by discussing the implications of the proposed solution and suggesting some directions for further research. It is hoped that this paper will contribute to the understanding of the problem and provide a useful starting point for others.
