Following is a notice of intention to do certain work as described below at the Shell

Petroleum Corporation W. D. Grimes Well No. 3 in S.W. quarter  
of Sec. 28, T. 18S, R. 28E, N. M. P. M., Hobbs  
Oil Field, Lea County.

DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

The well will be killed by pumping oil into the tubing. It is then proposed to repair the producing White Lime Section by placing approximately 1000 gallons of commercial Hydrochloric Acid Solution in the bottom of the hole. The well will then be shut in for about 72 hours before it is placed back on production.

Present potential of this well is 964 barrels. Gas-oil ratio is 765 since setting a packer, was 25,000 cu. ft. gas per barrel before setting the packer.

Repele Grimes No. 2, a direct north offset to the unit on which this well is located, has been acid treated. Present potential of this well is 2527 barrels.
