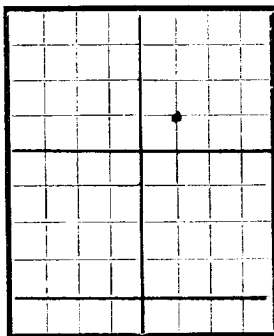

We propose to use the following strings of casing and to land or cement them as indicated:

It lists two casing strings: one 11 1/4 inch casing, 8 5/8 inch casing, 25.5 lb/ft, new, 300 feet deep, cemented, 175 sacks; and another 7 7/4 inch casing, 6 1/2 inch casing, 14 lb/ft, new, 3180 feet deep, cemented, 600 sacks.

If changes in the above plan become advisable we will notify you before cementing or landing casing. We estimate that the first productive oil or gas sand should occur at a depth of about 3180 feet.
