## ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION

Under the provisions of Division Order No.(s) R-6199, OCCIDENTAL PERMIAN LTD has made application to the Division on October 27, 2000 for permission to expand its North Hobbs Grayburg-San Andres Unit Pressure Maintenace Project.
