NOTICE OF TEST OF WATER SHUT-OFF

Notice must be given to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector at least five days before the test. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the water shut-off before drilling into the productive sand whenever possible. If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to sender. Submit this notice in duplicate.

You are hereby notified that we intend to test the shut-off of water in 9 5/8" Casing
Well No. 1 in SE 1/4 of Sec. 35, T. 18, R. 38,
N. M. P. M., Hobbs Oil Field Lee County,
on October 2, 1931 36 lb. casing was } cemented { in anhydrite
formation at a depth of 2941' feet on October 4, 1931
600 sacks of El Toro cement were used.

The method used in placing the cement was as follows:

Halliburton Process. Plug pumped to 2679'. 400# Calcium Chloride used with Cement.

Fluid level will be bailed to a depth of Bottom feet and left undisturbed for at least 12 hours before your inspection.

Adjacent property owners have been notified as follows: Continental & Midwest.

Additional information:

Well allowed to stand for two hours after fluid was bailed to bottom.
