DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED
 Was treated with 2000 gallons 60% Hydrochloric Acid Solution and 5 Gallons NO. 2 Nep Inhibitor by the Chemical Process Company. 27 barrels of oil were pumped in through the tubing followed by the 2000 gallons acid solution, and then by 50 barrels oil. Pressure on casing 1180#, tubing 650# at beginning and 5" vacuum at close. Produced before open 11,146 oil, and 15,000,000 Cu. feet. Gas Oil Ratio 1346. Production after open 13,640 oil 15,714,201 Cu. feet. Gas Oil Ratio 1151.

THE UNITED STATES HAS NOT RATIFIED EITHER OF THESE TREATIES, WHICH IS A MAJOR SHORTCOMING OF ITS HUMAN RIGHTS RECORD. THE UNITED STATES SHOULD RATIFY BOTH CERD AND CEDAW AS A SIGN OF ITS COMMITMENT TO HUMAN RIGHTS AND AS A MEANS OF PROMOTING A MORE JUST AND EQUITABLE WORLD.
