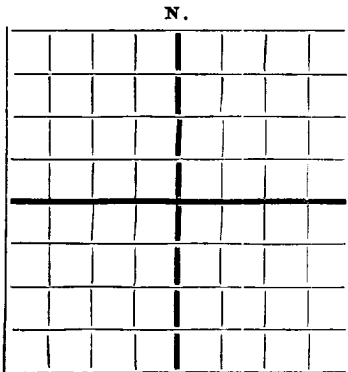

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO DRILL NEW WELL

Notice must be given to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector and approval obtained before drilling begins. If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to the sender. Submit this notice in triplicate. One copy will be returned following approval.

Dear Sir: You are hereby notified that it is our intention to commence the drilling of a well to be known as Turner Well No. 8 in SW of Sec. 34 T. 18 S, R. 39 E, N. M. P. M., Hobbs Oil Field Lea County

Make of Drill

We propose to use the following strings of casing and to land or cement them as indicated.

Table with 5 columns: Size of Casing, Weight Per Foot, New or Second Hand, Depth, Landed or Cemented. It lists three casing strings: 16 inch 70# New Lapweld, 10-3/4 inch 45.50# New Seamless, and 8-5/8 inch 36# New Seamless.

If changes in the above plan become advisable we will notify you before cementing or landing casing. We estimate that the first productive oil or gas sand should occur at a depth of about feet.

Additional information: Will spud by ROTARY METHOD, setting and cementing approximately 200' 16" conductor. Will drill by rotary method from this point thru Salt Beds into the lime, setting approximately 2700' 10-3/4" Seamless casing in the line. Will cement this string back thru the Salt Bed. Will complete by rotary method setting and cementing 8-5/8" 36# Seamless casing on top of the pay at approximately 3985'.
