NOTICE OF TEST OF WATER SHUT-OFF

Notice must be given to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector at least five days before the test. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the water shut-off before drilling into the productive sand whenever possible. If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to sender. Submit this notice in duplicate.

You are hereby notified that we intend to test the shut-off of water in W.D. Grimes
Well No. 1 in SE1/4 of Sec. 28, T. 18 S, R. 36E,
N. M. P. M., Hobbs Oil Field Lea County,
on About June 17 or 17, 34 9-5/8" 34 b. casing was ENTER { cemented { in Anhydrite
formation at a depth of 1637' feet on 6-12 1934
300 sacks of Eltere Cement 75 of which was Special cement were used.

The method used in placing the cement was as follows:

Pumped thru casing by Halliburton method.

Fluid level will be bailed to a depth of _____ feet and left undisturbed for at least 12 hours before your inspection.
