DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Squeezed off perforations from 3145 to 3150 with 82 sacks cement at a maximum and final pressure of 3600 p.s.i., re-perforated from 3156 to 3172 with 96 holes. Installed permanent type production packer at 3073 feet. After stabilization, flowed 37 barrels oil through a 3/4-inch choke in 12 hours. Tubing pressure equals 60 p.s.i., casing pressure equals 0 p.s.i. Gas oil ratio equals 13.333.
