

DATE	DEPTH	NATURE OF WORK PERFORMED
12-9-46	4601	Lee County Casing Pullers moved in unit and rigged up to plug well.
12-10-46	4601	Run tubing to mud hole.
12-11-46	4601	Mudded hole from 4548 to 4601. Ran 10 sacks cement 4468 to 4548.
12-12-46	4601	Ran in with tubing could not find cement plug. Recemented from 4468 to 4548' with 10 sacks cement.
12-13-46	4601	Shot 5-1/2" casing at 3300', did not come loose. Shot again at 3100' - now pulling casing.
12-14-46	4601	Pulling casing.
12-15-46	4601	Pulling casing.
12-16-46		Completed pulling 5-1/2" casing, total recovery 92 joints. Ran 10 sacks cement from 1819' to 1863'. Filled hole with mud to 32' and capped 8-5/8" casing with 10 sacks cement. Placed 4" X 18' pipe marker and filled cellar. Well plugged and abandoned.
