This well was completed November 9, 1939, total depth 4750', 7" OD casing was set at 4200' with 210 sax and 7 sax aquagel, initial production at time of completion 185 bbls. 24 hrs., natural. The present capacity is 15 bbls. oil per day.

It is the Magnolia's intention to drill this well deeper approximately 45' to explore the lower section of the San Andres Zone for production.
