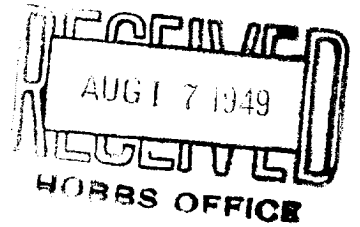

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On August 12, 1949 at 1:30 p.m. 48 hours had elapsed since running 4786' of 5 1/2" casing set at 4774' and cemented with 520 sacks to be used as oil string. Pipe and water shut off was tested by applying 1000 psi pressure and holding for 30 minutes before and after drilling plug. Pressure did not drop in excess of 100 psi on either test. Top of cement was determined by temperature survey at 3100'. Operations were resumed.
