DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

T. D. 4665 Lime. Loaded hole with 175 bbls. oil and introduced 1000 gal. Dowell XX. Bled 31 bbls. oil off casing while introducing acid thru tubing, controlling treatment from 4270' to total depth. Flushed tubing with 27 bbls. oil & swabbed off bottom 12 hours 12-20-38, recovering 225 bbls. oil, oil load and acid. 12-21-38 swabbed 92-1/2 bbls. fresh oil, 0 water in 24 hours, swabbing off bottom. Well was then shut in to prepare for a second acid treatment.
