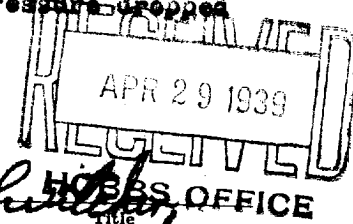

### DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Cemented 9-5/8", 36# casing at 1638' with 615 sacks of Oil Well cement, Halliburton process. Let stand 72 hours. Tested 9-5/8" casing with 1000# Hydraulic pressure, let stand 30 minutes pressure dropped to 950# Test O.K. Drilled plug at 1615' drilled cement out of casing and cleaned out to bottom at 1645'. Tested casing and formation with 1000# Hydraulic pressure. Let stand 30 minutes, pressure dropped to 990#, Test O.K.
