
Dear Ms. Swanson:

Pursuant to your request dated March 25, 1999, and for the reasons outlined in your letter, the expiration date of Administrative Order WFX-689 is hereby extended for 30-days to May 15, 1999.

Please be advised that no additional extensions of this order will be granted and that conversion of the Wallen Tonto Well No. 7 to an injection well subsequent to May 15, 1999 will require a new injection permit.

All other provisions contained within Order No. WFX-689 shall remain in full force and effect.

PRAIRIE CHICKENS

No surface use is allowed during the following time periods; unless otherwise specified, this stipulation does not apply to operation and maintenance of production facilities.

On the lands described below:

T-19S, R. 33E
Sec. 30 -ALL

For the purpose of: Protecting Prairie Chickens:

Drilling for oil and gas, and 3-D geophysical exploration operations will not be allowed in Lesser Prairie Chicken Habitat during the period of March 15 through June 15, each year. During that period, other activities that produce noise or involve human activity, such as the maintenance of oil and gas facilities, geophysical exploration other than 3-D operations, and pipeline, road, and well pad construction, will be allowed except between 3:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m. The 3:00a.m. and 9:00a.m. restriction will not apply to normal, around-the-clock operations, such as venting, flaring, or pumping, which do not require a human presence during the period. Additionally, no new drilling will be allowed within up to 200 meters of leaks known at the time of permitting. Normal vehicle use on existing roads will not be restricted. Exhaust noise from pump jack engines must be muffled or otherwise controlled so as not to exceed 75 db measured at 30 feet from the source of the noise.
