As our Mr. Boone advised you by telephone on November 21, 1956, The Texas Company intends to drill a well to a depth of approximately 11,500' to explore for oil and gas at a location 640' from the South and East lines of Section 25, Township 20-S, Range 12-E, Los County, New Mexico. The objective depth of this well will be in the Devonian formation.

Enclosed are photostatic copies of our intention to drill and accompanying plan which we have filed with the United States Geological Survey and New Mexico Conservation Commission.

This proposed well will be drilled on our captioned lease and others covering the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 25 and the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 26, Township 20-S, Range 12-E, Los County, New Mexico. The larger working oil interests in the mentioned SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 25 and the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 26 have been committed to a unit plan, and the well will be drilled under such unit plan.

Order No. E-111-A of the Oil Conservation Commission of the State of New Mexico requires that prior to commencing operations on any lease within the patch area the operator shall furnish one copy by registered mail of the notice of intention to drill as well as a map or plan to accompany each copy to all patch operators holding patch leases within a radius of one mile of the proposed wellsite.

As our Mr. Hensley advised you by telephone on November 21, 1956, The Texas Company intends to drill a well to a depth of approximately 14,000' to explore for oil and gas at a location 600' from the south and east lines of Section 22, Township 20-S, Range 22-E, Los Compadres, New Mexico. The objective depth of this well will be in the formation.

Enclosed are photostatic copies of our intention to drill and accompanying plan which we have filed with the United States Geological Survey and New Mexico Conservation Commission.

This proposed well will be drilled on our captioned lease and others covering the SE 1/4 of said Section 22 and the SW 1/4 of Section 20, Township 20-S, Range 22-E, Los Compadres, New Mexico. The location covered by this lease is shown on the plan, and the well will be drilled under such unit plan.

Order No. W-111-A of the Oil Conservation Commission of the State of New Mexico requires that prior to commencing operations on any lands within the process area the operator shall furnish a copy by registered mail of its notice of intention to drill as well as a map or plan to accompany each copy to all persons operators holding patent leases within a radius of one mile of the proposed well(s).

Our information reflects that Farmers Chemical Resources Development Corporation is the potash lessee on lands located within one mile of the mentioned test, such lease being all of Section 26, Township 28-S, Range 32-E, Lea County, New Mexico. This letter will serve as notice of our intention to drill the above mentioned well. The Texas Company will abide by the potash regulations of both R-111-A and Federal regulations, where appropriate.

As we desire to commence the drilling of our mentioned test on or about the first of December, your expediting the matter will be sincerely appreciated.
