

Gentlemen:

Receipt is acknowledged of your "Notice of Intention to Drill" dated May 22, 1956, covering your well No. 1 Mustang-Federal, a 15,000-foot test on the subject leasehold located 660 feet from the south line and 1926 feet from the west line of section 7, T. 20 S., R. 33 E., N.M.P.M., potash area, Lea County, New Mexico

Your proposed work is hereby approved subject to compliance with the provisions of the "Oil and Gas Operating Regulations" revised May 25, 1942, a copy of which will be furnished you upon request and subject to the following conditions:

- (1) Drilling operations so authorized are subject to the attached sheet for general conditions of approval.
- (2) The depths at which you propose to set the surface casing and the salt protection string, are not satisfactory. The drilling and casing program must conform with the special potash area regulations of New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Order No. R-111-A.
- (3) Notify this office in sufficient time to arrange for a representative to witness all cementing operations and all casing and water shut-off tests.
