DETAILS OF WORK

**Juett-McDonald AA #3** was drilled to a total depth of **3645'**. The **9 5/8"** casing was set @ **1478.77'**. Cement circulated. The **7"** casing was set @ **3320'**. Cement circulated. There was no evidence of commercial production. The well was plugged as follows: (1) loaded hole w/mud laden fluid; (2) spotted 80 sack, plug from **3645' - 3240'** to seal off open hole; (3) spotted 10 sacks cement from **30'** to surface. The cellar and pits have been filled, levelled and location cleared of all debris. Plugging was completed **March 5, 1961** and is ready for inspection.
