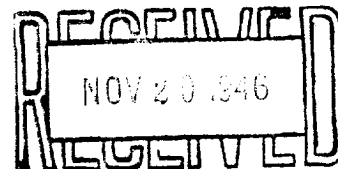

## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Total Depth, 4046 - Lime. 7" casing cemented at 3700' with 300 sacks.

No production test was made before shooting, due to the fact that the well was shut in because of high gas-oil ratio in September, 1942. After cleaning out to bottom, well was shot on 10-30-45 with 220 quarts of nitro-glycerin from 3980' to 4040', using a 1-yard gravel tamp. After cleaning out to 4017' well flowed 4.14 barrels oil, 50% water in 24 hours with GOR 27,500. The well is now shut in because of excessive Gas Oil Ratio.
