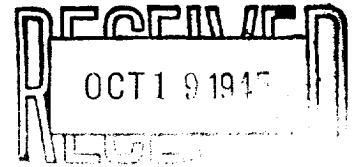

Well now has Lane Wells anchor type packer set in open hole at 3375/79. Gas-oil ratio has increased to 1115/1. Plan to do the following work in attempt to correct gas-oil ratio:

Kill well with oil, unseat packer, swab in and run new temperature survey with well thru casing to determine base of gas; then kill well, pull tubing, caliper hole, and rerun tubing with Guilberson Spiral Gum packer w/ 10' element to set at determined point, treat packer with packer seal, and swab in for production test.
