Attached is NMOCC Form C-104 filed for change of purchaser and NMOCC Form C-102 showing acreage to be dedicated to Shell Foster No. 2, for a non-standard proration unit in the Eumont Pool.

Shell-Foster No. 2 was shut-in April 29, 1982 and will remain shut-in until separate metering facilities are installed. We plan to hook the well up to El Paso Natural Gas Sales line in the near future.

Foster No. 2 was reclassified as a gas well in the Eumont Pool effective September 1, 1981. In October 1981, the pumping unit was shut down when the rods parted and was not repaired; however, the casing valve was inadvertantly left open allowing gas to bleed down the flowline. This led to our confusion as to the status of Shell-Foster No. 2.

We regret any inconvenience this has caused and trust the above explanation will help clarify the situation.
