DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

5207' Total Depth, Line. Acidised with 1000 gallons of Dowell W-17 15% Low Tension Acid and started acid in tubing at 1:00AM, 3-9-48. At 1:20AM, acid on formation, 1300# on tubing. At 1:35AM formation broke with 1500# on tubing, 18 bbls. acid in. At 1:40AM 20 bbls. oil flush complete with 650# on tubing and 24 bbls. acid in formation. Swabbed and flowed estimated 40 bbls. oil and acid water to pits and at 3:30AM turned to tanks on 16/64" choke. In 24 hr. test well flowed 275.31 bbls. of oil, 5/10%BS&W, on 16/64" choke, gravity 39.2 corrected. Gas volume 118,100 cu. ft. per day, Gas-Oil-Ratio 429. Well completed.
