

- (D) That the granting of this application for permission to produce the well as a dual completion with gas from the Seven Rivers and oil from the Queen is in the interest of conservation and the protection of correlative rights.
- (E) That the applicant will comply with all the rules and regulations of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission to maintain separation of production from the two pay zones.
- (F) That the manner and method of the proposed dual completion is mechanically feasible and practical.
- (G) That by copy of this letter of application by registered mail, all offset operators are notified of the proposed dual completion.

Therefore, Amerada Petroleum Corporation requests that the Oil Conservation Commission grant permission to the applicant to dually complete the subject well as proposed in this application.
