Gentlemen:

D4 and C-110, our New Mexico State B-2. Hold Sec. 10, T-19-S, R-37-E, was are sumont Pool. As reflected by our Forms C-104 and C-110, our New Mexico State E-2, Unit "M", located in SW 1/4 of SW 1/4 of Sec. 10, T-19-S, R-37-E, was completed June 15, 1956, as an oil well from the sumont Pool.

We were notified by Ar. A. L. Porters, Jr's. letter, cated July 25, 1956, that in order to comply with order R-553 we must either contain a connection for the sale of the casing head gas from our well or secure the exception from 10)4/16 three the "no flare" order prior to September 15, 1956.

Gas contract with Warren Petroleum Corporation to take the gas from this well is being negotiated and we expect them to connect and start taking gas from this well so etime in the near future.

In view of these facts, we respectifully request that Humble Oil & Refining Company be granted a ninety-day exception to the "no flare" provisions of the Eumont pool rules so that we might continue producing from this well.

Your early consideration of this matter will be appreciated.
